

Rules for use of the Facility

Please follow the rules so we will be welcomed back

- No seating tiers may be moved by the USER at any time
- Any picnic tables, benches, chairs, etc. moved by the USER must be returned to their original locations
- No open fires for any reason
- No vehicles may be parked on the berms or grassed areas of the show grounds
- No vehicles may drive upon and/or be parked upon the pad immediately next to the row of temporary stall
- RV's, trailers, and other show-related vehicles may be permitted to park overnight during the event but only in specified areas and not blocking access to the garbage disposal or exits
- No dogs, participants, trailers, RV's, or other vehicles related to the Edmonton Kennel Club Dog show will be permitted past the show grounds area into the WEC's main site which starts at the first set of white gates into the main parking lot outside the barnyard area

Camping Rules & Day Tent Rules

All parking is privilege extended by the Edmonton Kennel Club. Any arguing or abusive language or failure to follow these rules, regulation or instructions of the parking personnel will cause you to loose your parking privilege, you will be escorted from the show site and forfeit all parking privileges without refund of fees and possible discipline by the event committee.

All parking is at the owner's risk. The Edmonton Kennel Club and Whitemud Equine Learning Centre assume no responsibility of liability for damages for loss of vehicle or personal property.

Fire lane and drive way must be kept clear at all times

All overnight parking units must be totally self contained. No dumping of gray water or sewage will be tolerated.

All overnight vehicles and tow vehicles must fit within assigned reserved space

Generator exhaust must be vented up and away from neighbours. Hours of operation 6:00 am to 10:00 pm

Reserved sites and day use areas must be kept clean as all times and MST be left clean when you leave. This is a self clean event. All exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs, grooming and camping area. There are large receptacle bins for your convenience. Please use them.

Clean up after your dog is a must in this facility

Day Tents, in designated areas only. You will be assessed a \$20.00 cash deposit. At the end of the show if the site is left clean your deposit will be returned.
